# Stage Updates Nearing Completion

\$15,000 given in the spring for our Auction Fund A Need project is refreshing the stage!



It's been fun to watch the transformation of the stage throughout the past few months. Thanks to the generous support of many friends, we celebrate together as this year's Auction Fund A Need project nears completion!



Here's an overview of what's been done:

- The support structure was redesigned to improve stability, maximize space, and improve the ease of moving the storage carts that hold tables and chairs.
- An additional layer of new plywood flooring was installed on top of the existing floor, creating a much more firm surface!
- The walls, ceiling, and flooring have received a fresh coat of black paint, creating a crisp and cohesive look. Special thanks to Sanford King for donating his time and talent!
- The utility space between the stage and hallway has been redesigned as a secure electrical and customized sound storage closet.
- New doors for the storage area were handcrafted and installed by Dave, providing easy access to the table and chairs stored underneath.
- New curtains for the front of the stage were purchased and installed. It all looks amazing!
