PA Tax Credit Program Funds Valuable Scholarships

The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program has been supporting private schools for more than 20 years. Simply put, it allows both individuals and businesses to redirect their PA tax dollars to Belleville Christian School. In 2025-26, more than \$170,000 provided by our EITC business partners and endowments was awarded, significantly impacting the educational experience of more than half of our families!
